5. Updates and Reports

- **BVS Director update:**

- Analysing the Scientist survey that was carried out, majority of scientists are happy with BVS. Work could be done on communication.
- Survey showed there is a need for more surgical support from BVS, have identified different career pathways for technicians to support the scientists needs.
- Reviewing first draft of BVS guidelines to be shared with AWERB for input.
- Steering committee has been set up for the new facility at [REDACTED], first meeting being held in June.
- Virtual tours of facilities being recorded as part of leadership in openness.

- **NVS update:**

- LARIF: submission of 2 potential non compliances, PIL holders reminded of responsibilities.
- An NVS is leaving after 17 years, job has been advertised to replace
- Interviewing for Animal Research Data Manager within BVS
- Annual refreshers have gone very well
- 3rs day focus on replacement feedback was positive, around 60 people attended, although not many project licence holders attended

- **NTCO update:**

- Completed modular training for PIL course, 57 people attended in March
- Next course in June, 36 registered so far
- Working with LARIF to look at SOP documents to ensure format is consistent across facilities
